## Vietnam GDP to grow 10% annually by 2030

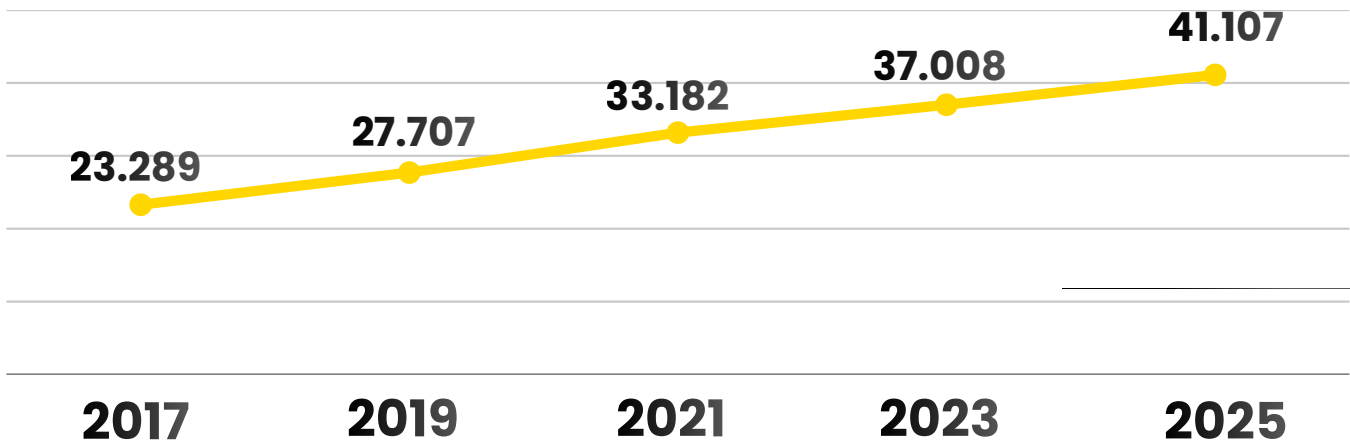
Vietnam targets **10 percent** annual GDP growth through 2030, aiming to become Southeast Asia's third-largest economy.

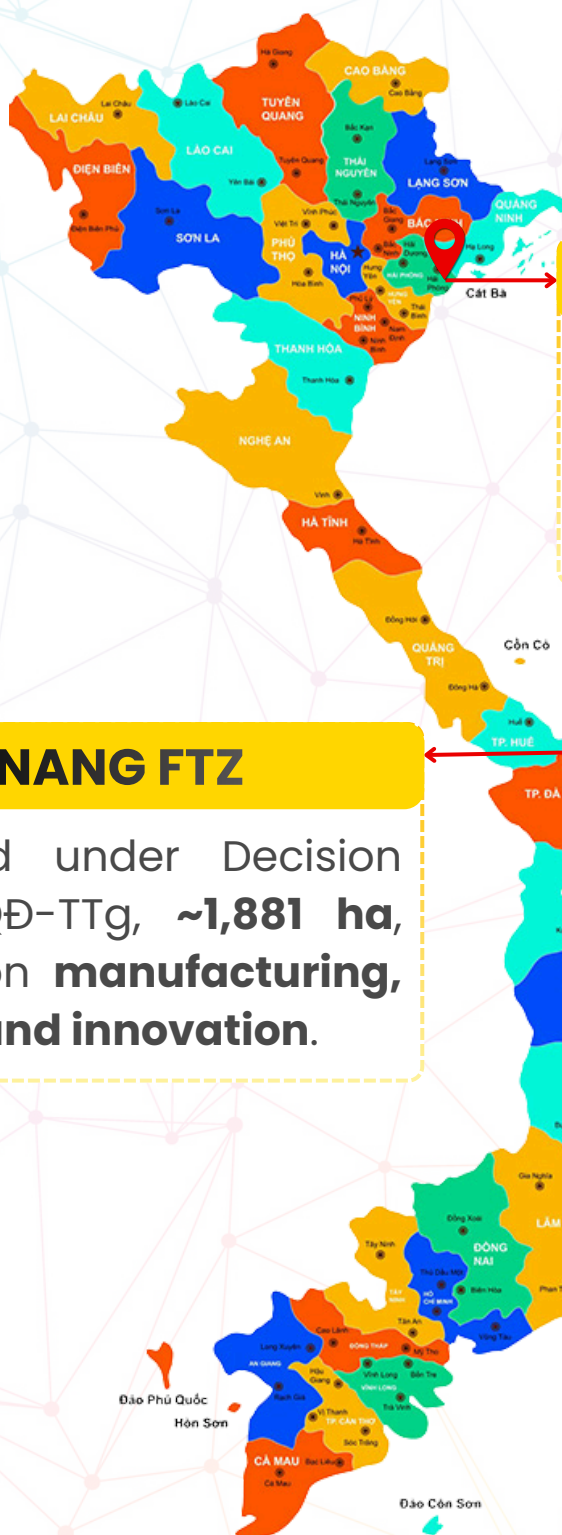

### DA NANG FTZ

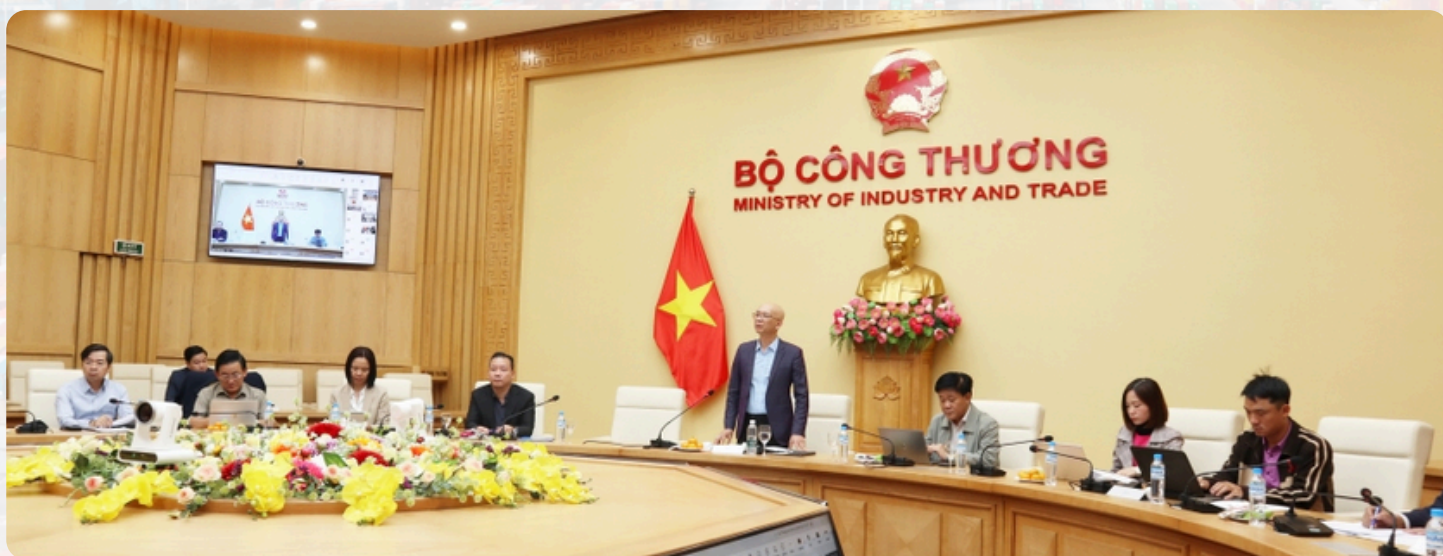
Established under Decision No. 1142/QĐ-TTg, **~1,881 ha**, focusing on **manufacturing, logistics, and innovation.**

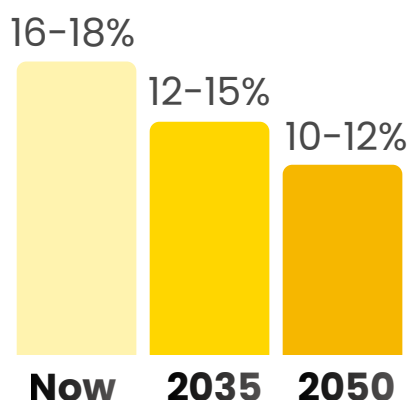
## MOIT launches Vietnam Logistics Strategy 2025-2035

The Ministry of Industry and Trade launched Vietnam's first comprehensive **Logistics Development Strategy** for 2025–2035, with a vision to 2050.

## HCMC rises 3 places in Global Financial Centres Index

HCMC has risen to **95th** on the Global Financial Centres Index, three spots up from earlier this year, overtaking in the process Thailand's Bangkok for the first time.

**HCMC scored 664**, up 10 points from March, and was named among the **15 financial centers** projected to see strong growth in the next two or three years.

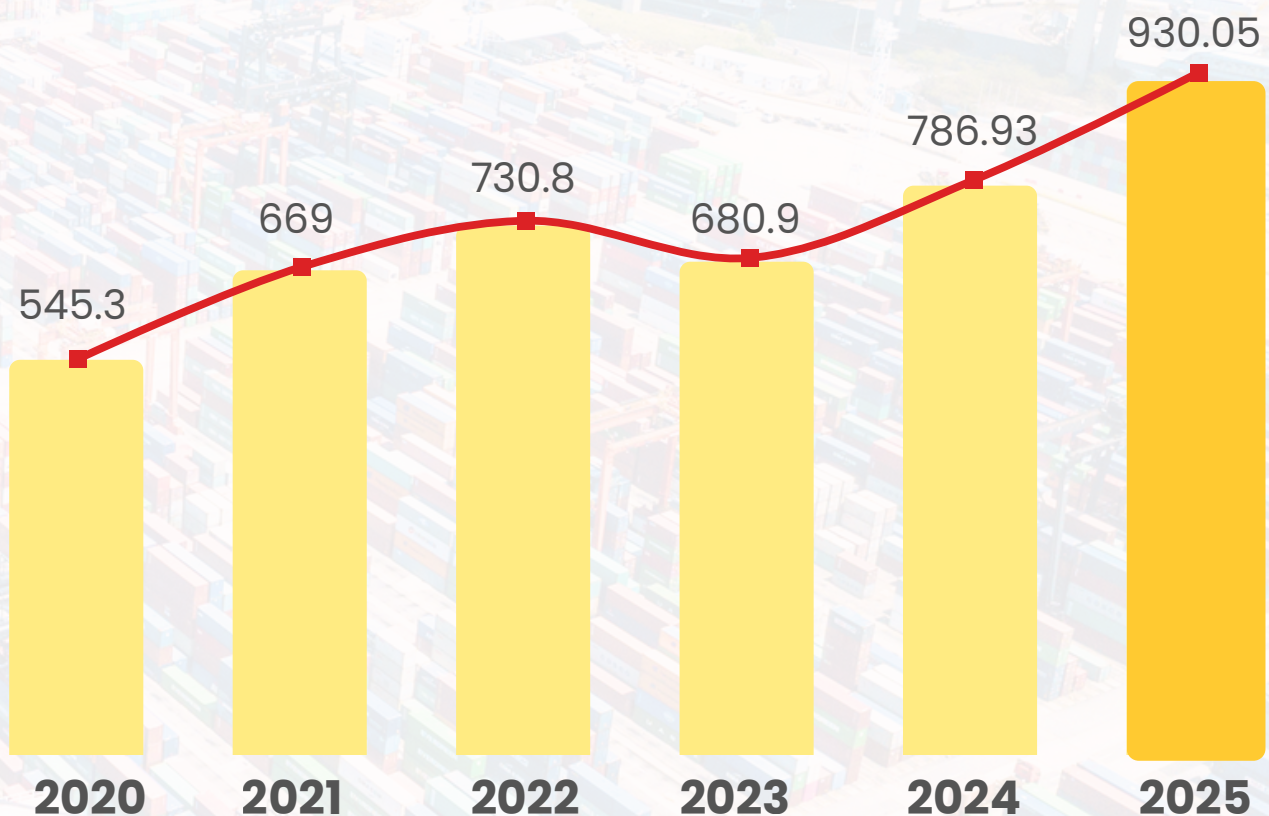

## Vietnam's trade value topped \$930 billion in 2025

Import and export turnover in 2025 is projected to exceed 930 billion USD, **1.7 times higher than in 2020**; the trade surplus is estimated to be over 20 billion USD.
